The International Behavioural and Neural Genetics Society was established in 1996 to promote growth of research in the field of neural behavioral genetics. The society has academic and corporate members worldwide that study the genetic basis of a wide range of behaviors and brain disorders together with the underlying neuronal mechanisms using diverse species. For the past 24 years the annual meeting has attracted 100-150 participants drawn from multiple countries and included a scientific program of plenary lectures, symposia, selected talks, award ceremonies and poster sessions.
